We are pleased to report that our March 2016 work trips to begin vertical construction at the Delmas 9 construction site were a tremendous success!

The daunting task of taking 25 tons of steel lying on the concrete slab and having it all in its place in 7 days was quite overwhelming. The fact that a second crew of masons would arrive the next day and would have to place over 4,000 CMU blocks over the next 7 days added to the challenge. However, with the help of the Lord and the hard work of the brethren of the Body of Christ, the work was completed in 2 weeks!

Special thanks to all those who have participated so far in the work trips. We are off to a great start and are looking forward to many exciting trips in the future. The men returned with wonderful testimonies of feeling blessed to participate in such a momentous project.
