



WORK TRIP PACKING SUGGESTIONS

- Tool bag or back pack to carry personal items in.
- Hat or Ball cap
- Gloves
- Leather work boots
- Sun Screen SPF 100
- Insect Repellent DEET 100
- Small bottles of hand sanitizer to carry in your pocket. (2-3)
- Bath soap
- Wash clothes
- Small flashlight
- 6" Battery fan from Academy, Wal-Mart or Gander Mountain
- Tool belt
- ½" Ratchet with ¾" deep socket
- 3/4" Combination wrench
- 10"-12" Crescent wrench
- Tape measure
- Impact screw gun battery operated (optional)
 - If any power tools lithium batteries, the batteries must be disconnected from the power tool and the contacts on the battery must be insulated. This is per American Airlines instructions.
- Welders be sure to bring your own hood and hand tools.
- Sunglasses
- Because we are at the jobsite for long periods of time; therefore workers may choose to carry a few snacks with them in their back packs.
- You can check with your physician concerning travel to Haiti, however this is what most of us do that go frequently to Haiti:
 - Have a current tetanus shot
 - Start taking Malaria medicine such as Doxycycline or whichever type your physician prescribes prior to departure and continue taking recommended doses after return home as prescribed.
 - (Optional) Due to the possibility of catching a bug from their water etc. travelers going to Haiti commonly carry a prescription called Ciprofloxacin HCL to cure the problem

Haitian Customs Declaration papers and a green Haitian Foreign Passport form will be issued on the airplane prior to landing in Haiti. Use the sample form included in this packet to fill out the forms using your own name, address, passport number and date of birth etc... What is important to have correct is the address and phone number as listed on the sample for our address while in Haiti. Just prior to leaving immigrations they will give the bottom part of the form back. **YOU MUST HAVE THIS FORM ALONG WITH YOUR PASSPORT AND TICKET TO LEAVE HAITI.**
